- Sonoma Clean Power Second Revision of Draft Concept Paper Video conference w/Rebecca from Sonoma
  Clean Power (SCP) to review draft proposal for solar generation at the treatment plant. Draft #2 was produced
  from our conference. I will provide edits and include costs estimates for upgrading ozone unit to UV unit. Fortner
  Consulting in Fort Bragg is drafting the replacement estimate.
- DWR Grant \$1.345m Total, Awaiting PG&E for Approval & Trench Repair PG&E Permit has yet to authorize solar system to go live. No date expected yet. New solar array conduit trench settled and needed gravel, Wylatti completed the repair. Denise @ Humboldt County sent Sub-Grant Agreement Amendment 2, GM signed, & emailed back. We are set to invoice upon project closure.
- EPA WaterTA Grant None.
- FEMA/CalOES Emergency Assistance Projects "Engaged for Closeout" Project funds are "obligated," final review and approval needed to release the "hold" on the account. Once the release is made check can be sent.
- Waterboards Technical Assistance Grant 2024 None.
